

5.07 OTHER DOH FUNDING

Some SCAs may receive additional funding other than that received through State funds (Appropriation 10-653), Federal SAPTBG funds (Appropriation 70-327) and federal SDFSCA funds (Appropriation 80-134) in any given SFY. These funds are, in general, other Federal grant funds allocated by BDAP that are targeted for special projects. Funds are typically awarded through a selective Request For Application (RFA) process and may be awarded to one or several SCAs depending upon the availability of funds in the grant award.

These funds may be budgeted according to the specific boundaries of the project and as directed by BDAP. Specific reports relative to special initiatives must be completed by the SCAs as prescribed by the agreement. The report parameters are outlined in the agreement or a subsequent amendment to the agreement with the SCAs. Reporting format and instructions are generally provided to the recipient of funds through separate correspondence forwarded from BDAP.

The SCA may not expend more special initiative funding than is allocated in the Schedule of Funding for a particular SFY. Under certain circumstances, funds drawn down by the SCA but not spent during the SFY may be carried forward into the new SFY, based upon instruction from BDAP.
