  2. Any community involvement (volunteer or service activities), special contributions you take pride in, or volunteer positions that promote community well-being or the well-being of individuals.
  3. Your involvement with your youth group and how it has affected your life and/or your future goals.
  4. Specific areas of personal or academic growth and achievement in high school that you want to share with the committee (including awards and honors).
  5. How your educational path supports your life goals and reflects your values.
